



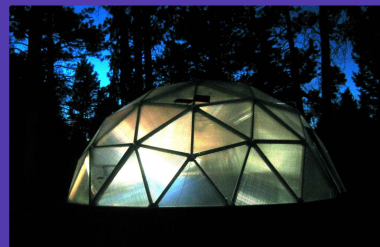
GLOBAL CHILDREN'S GARDENS



PROPOSAL

Global Children's Gardens proposes to the Evergreen Parks and Recreation Board and Executive Director and the Evergreen community:

- To construct a geodesic dome greenhouse at Buchanan Park on land previously developed but currently vacant
- Greenhouse to be built, operated and managed by GCG as a model of sustainability and productivity; producing organic vegetables, herbs and flowers year-round
- To provide a venue and curriculum for Environmental Education courses serving Evergreen Schools, home school groups, senior, families and individuals
- To develop and direct a Horticultural Therapy program for seniors and developmentally disabled children and adults
- Encourage other local non-profits to develop and offer programming at the Green House at Buchanan Park: i.e. Arts, Theater, Music, Dance, Gardening.



FUNDING

GCG proposes this project without requesting Evergreen Recreation District or tax payer dollars. We will build from a community of support: individuals, families, businesses, foundations, GoCo Colorado and the Colorado Garden and Home Show.

GROWING DOMES

Growing Domes are constructed from kits manufactured by Growing Spaces in Pagosa Springs, Colorado. Domes are aesthetically appealing, energy self sufficient, productive year round, immune from wind, hail, or snow damage, and proven to be very durable with minimal yearly maintenance. The dome shape itself is a very rigid structure, comparably very light which dramatically reduces the foundation requirements. Domes can actually be disassembled and relocated if necessary or desirable.
